







The children behave well in school.



The school responds well to my concerns and keeps me well informed




My child makes me feel proud when they talk about the work they have produced in school.



Section 3

Parent suggestions with headteacher response

Thank you to the seven parents who added something in the 'Suggestions' box. We have attempted to address your ideas below and we continually seek outside agencies to come in and validate our work. This year we have achieved the Platinum Artsmark award, which only two other primary schools have in Essex, and the Inclusion Quality Mark. Both their reports can be found on our website. Our results have been moderated by the Local Authority and quality assured.

"More homework would be helpful so I can help support my child's learning further and to know what my child is learning about and their progression."

Each year group has a homework grid on our website designed to give all children activities which provide a chance to practice/ pursue interests linked to the termly learning journey. They also have daily reading practice and in years 2-6 Mathletics homework is set. We review homework on an annual basis.

"Not all children behave well."

All staff work hard to help children to make good choices and to work hard in their learning. Some children need more reminders than others.

"Take a deeper look into bullying."

We take bullying very seriously. A log is kept and it is regularly reviewed by governors. Children are encouraged to talk to adults and discuss any concerns. Bullying online has increased over the past years and we are constantly reminding children to behave responsibly online, each of our computing learning units has an e safety element.

"Menu needs work. Not healthy enough, needs more fruit and less saturated fats."

Menus are designed by Essex School Meals services to meet the National Guidelines. Fresh fruit is available for all children every day.

"Children should be rewarded more for meeting and improving targets ie reading and maths. Should get certificates and get rewarded for good attendance. I know my son would do better if he felt he was achieving and getting rewards like certificates, not just for code of conduct."

Every week during our Celebration Assemblies certificates are given out to each class for Learning and Code of Conduct. Each term children with 100% attendance are entered into a grand draw and win a prize – these have included a family ticket to Marsh Farm and Cinema tickets.

"Further extensions for pupils exceeding expectations."

This was an area for development from our Ofsted report in 2018 and the number of children achieving at greater depth across the school has since increased. We will keep this under constant review.

"Nothing to be added, keep up the hard work, my daughter has truly enjoyed her time here."
