Research a piece of art that you like and try to draw it. Who is the artist, when was it painted, what type of art is it? etc.	Write a winter fairy tale	Research an animal that lives in the Artic or Antarctica and create a fact sheet	Design and create a Christmas card and send to a teacher	Learn the British Sign Language signs for 'Jingle Bells' and sign and sing along

You will receive 1 hour of CU Learning for each of the activities you complete.

You must provide evidence of each activity you complete and you can show this to your CU school coordinator. Depending on the challenge, there are many different ways to display your work, for example:

- Tell us when you completed it, who with, what steps did you take etc.
