Take One Picture Project – National Gallery



Safety in the Sun



Shade - The availability of shade is considered when planning outdoor activities and children are encouraged to use available areas of shade when outside.

Hats - We ask that children bring a sun hat to school (spare hats are kept in classes for younger children to borrow when working in outdoor areas.)

Sunscreen - We ask that parents /carers apply all-day water resistant sunscreen at the beginning of the day, especially if the UV levels are high. Pupils can bring a named bottle of sunscreen to school, so that they can re-apply if necessary.

Water - Children will be encouraged to maintain their water intake in hot weather. Please ensure that they bring a water bottle to school; there is access to water throughout the day.

Curriculum All pupils will be reminded to be 'sunsmart' in the summer term and behaviour is regularly reinforced and promoted to the whole school community through posters and school assemblies.

Attendance Matters

Attending school is essential for students to make good progress, achieve their academic potential and consequently have better life chances.

Every student is expected by the **Government** to maintain at least 96.1% attendance.

Below are examples of how attendance impacts on learning over a year and five year period:

One year:

98% - approximately 4 days absent.

95% - approximately 10 days absent.

90% - approximately 4 weeks absent.

85% - approximately 5 $1\!\!\!/_{\!2}$ weeks absent.

80% - approximately 7 ½ weeks absent Over a five year period:

85-90% is similar to half a year off school.

80% is similar to having a whole year off school

Please inform the school if your child will be absent or late for any reason (01376 321814).

The school gates close at 8.55am and all pupils should be in school by that time. If a pupil is late or at an appointment and needs to come in via the school office then a parent will need to accompany

the child and sign them in as late. Collection times remain as follows:

> Foundation Stage: 2.55pm Lower School: 3.05pm Middle School: 3.10pm Upper School: 3.15pm

Holidays and absence in Term Time

We have received an unprecedented number of holiday request forms in the last two weeks. Whilst we do understand that holidays may have had to be rebooked, due to the Pandemic, it is the position of the Local Authority that pupils should not be granted leave of absence in term time unless for an exceptional reason. To comply with the attendance regulations parents MUST please complete an absence request form for any time that they are planning to take their child out of school, even if they know that it will be unauthorised. It is the directive of the Local Authority that if a parent decides to take their child out of school for 5 days or more that they will incur a Penalty Notice of £60 per parent per child. This money does not go to the school but to the Local Authority.

Queens Platinum Jubilee Interactive Safari Beacon Trail, 30th April – 12th June & Colouring Competition

An exciting family trail has been launched in Braintree to celebrate the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. Families can visit the High Street Safari website to locate the first story point and then head out to start their mission.

At the first location children need to hunt for a Jubilee-themed character which will usually be displayed in the window of the premises. There will be a QR to scan which reveals the first instalment of the story and allows children to see them in augmented reality.

From there participants are led to six other destinations around the town, with each one offering a new character to collect and the next part of the story.

The free trails are live now and run until 12th June, giving families plenty of time to take part.
