Find out about two different musical instruments in Ancient Egypt. What sounds did they make?	Compare musical instruments used now and in Ancient Egyptian times.	Which Ancient Egyptian musical instrument would you most like to learn to play? Why?	Write a song/tune that would be played when worshipping one of the ancient Gods. It could just be your voice or it could have instruments.
