Earrings

All jewellery needs to be removed for PE. Taping earrings for any reason is not allowed under the **Essex County Council Health & Safety Policy**. If children can remove their earrings, we can put them in a small envelope to take home. However, if they cannot take their earrings out children will have to sit out of PE. With this in mind, if you intend to have your child's ears pierced we recommend that you do so at the start of the summer break, allowing time for them to heal and for the earrings to be safely removed without closing.

Safety Notice

Bikes and scooters can only be brought into school by years 5 and 6. We continue to speak to all children about safety whilst riding and the importance of wearing a cycle helmet. Last term our community police officers visited and spoke with children, reiterating that helmets are essential when riding bikes and indeed they gave the statistics of how many serious accidents they attend which involve cyclists. Two of our own children were involved in accidents on the way to school and thankfully incurred only minor injuries. Please ensure your child wears their helmet.
