


### World Book Day

### Safer Internet Day

### Year 5 visit to Public Gardens

This term Year 5 children have been developing their mapping skills which they will use to design and draw a proposed fun theme park in Braintree.

Last Tuesday they visited the Braintree and Bocking Public Gardens to get inspiration for their designs. The children used trundle wheels to measure the perimeter of the park and they also used the time to plan the layout of their theme parks.

The mapping and design projects are still in progress, and we hope to share their amazing prototypes with you once completed.



### Year 2 – Victorian Day

Year 2 will be visiting Braintree Museum for a Victorian Day on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> February. We would like the children to dress up as Victorian children. We suggest that boys wear long trousers tucked into their socks or jogging bottoms, a plain shirt (perhaps an old shirt with the collar removed), possibly a waistcoat and a flat cap. We suggest that girls wear a long dress or skirt and perhaps an apron and a shawl. However, their outfit should be suitable for the weather as we will be walking to the museum so sensible shoes and a warm coat are essential.

### National Walk and Talk Day

In support of National Walk & Talk Day on Sunday 6th February 2022, Active Essex are encouraging schools to Go outside, Get Active and Talk. Between the 7th-13th February, Active Essex are asking schools to complete a 1 mile walk whilst talking to fellow students. We will be building this into our school curriculum during the week, as it is a great way to make students feel calmer, re-energised and increase their concentration levels by getting fresh air, taking part in physical activity and talking.
