## Residential Trip 2023 - Current Year 5 pupils

We are delighted to tell you that we have organised a 4 day (3 night) residential trip for next year's Year 6 pupils at Kingswood in Norfolk. This will take place between Tuesday 14th - Friday 17th March 2023. There will be a range of exciting activities for the children to take part in. #### **Attendance Matters**

Attending school is essential for students to make good progress, achieve their academic potential and consequently have better life chances.

Every student is expected by the **Government** to maintain at least 96.1% attendance.

Below are examples of how attendance impacts on learning over a year and five year period:

#### One year:

98% - approximately 4 days absent.

95% - approximately 10 days absent.

90% - approximately 4 weeks absent.

85% - approximately 5 ½ weeks absent.

80% - approximately 7 ½ weeks absent
Over a five year period:

85-90% is similar to half a year off school.

80% is similar to having a whole year off school

The school gates close at 8.55am and all pupils should be in school by that time. If a pupil is late or at an appointment and needs to come in via the school office then a parent will need to accompany the child and sign them in as late.

Please inform the school if your child will be absent or late for any reason (01376 321814).

#### Holidays and absence in Term Time

Whilst we do understand that holidays may have had to be rebooked, due to the Pandemic, it is the position of the Local Authority that pupils should not be granted leave of absence in term time unless for an **exceptional reason**. To comply with the attendance regulations parents MUST please complete an absence request form for any time that they are planning to take their child out of school, even if they know that it will be unauthorised. It is the directive of the Local Authority that if a parent decides to take their child out of school for **5 days** or more that they will incur a Penalty Notice of £60 per parent per child. This money does not go to the school but to the Local Authority.
